

IMPORTANT ADVICE REGARDING WORKING HOURS, DELIVERIES AND CAR PARKING

The following actions have been agreed with Babergh District Council with immediate effect:

Working hours

- No noise intrusive works outside of the agreed hours for weekdays are permitted – any further breaches leave the developer, and the individual operative, liable to prosecution (for the avoidance of doubt, noise intrusive works include the use of power tools, machinery or plant, or any use outside of hand-held tools that create noise, e.g. hammering).
- All weekend working will cease until further notice.
- There will be no further working on Sundays or Bank/Public holidays

Deliveries and parking

- Site staff and contractors will park within the site compound unless in exceptional circumstances, when they will park considerately and only at the south end of Ellen Aldous Avenue on the east (development) side of the road, away from the junction with Emma Girling Close.
- Any deliveries/collections to/from the development will be carried out within the site except in exceptional circumstances when they can be made directly outside the current southern site access as indicated in the below image. A member of site staff will oversee all deliveries and collections to ensure this.
